

# *MEMO FROM THE SECRETARY*

## *April 2006*

- Your help is needed as we prepare to kick off the 2006 season. Please join us on Saturday, April 1<sup>st</sup>, from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. when we will have our clean-up day.
- The 2006 OVKA rulebook can be viewed and downloaded from our website. Printed copies will be available at the track beginning with Karting 101.
- The 2006 membership application is available online. Sending in your membership renewal during the off-season helps lessen the paperwork when we start the new season.
- If you have a new driver who is signing up, please provide documentation of age. Proof of age can be a copy of a driver's license, birth certificate or passport.
- Kart numbers will be held through the first points race. Please refer to OVKA rule #103 for further explanation.
- We are lining up corner workers for the 2006 season. If you can help at any of the races, please let me know so we can get as many filled prior to the start of the season.
- Participation credits can be earned throughout the year in a variety of ways. Drivers can apply these credits toward year-end participation for banquet drawings if they have missed any races. A credit can be earned for working a four hour shift at work days, promotional events, the Swap Meet, and at races in lieu of reimbursement. An individual may work for a participation credit for another person but must convey this to the designated O.V.K.A. representative by October 31, 2006. (In order to receive participation prizes and grand prizes, the driver must be registered for the banquet and be present at the time of drawings.)
- Please be patient with registration staff as the season begins. We will be using a new registration computer program which will take some time for all of us to learn. This new method will include issuing membership cards that will be scanned into the system. As with any new process, it will take us time to become proficient.
